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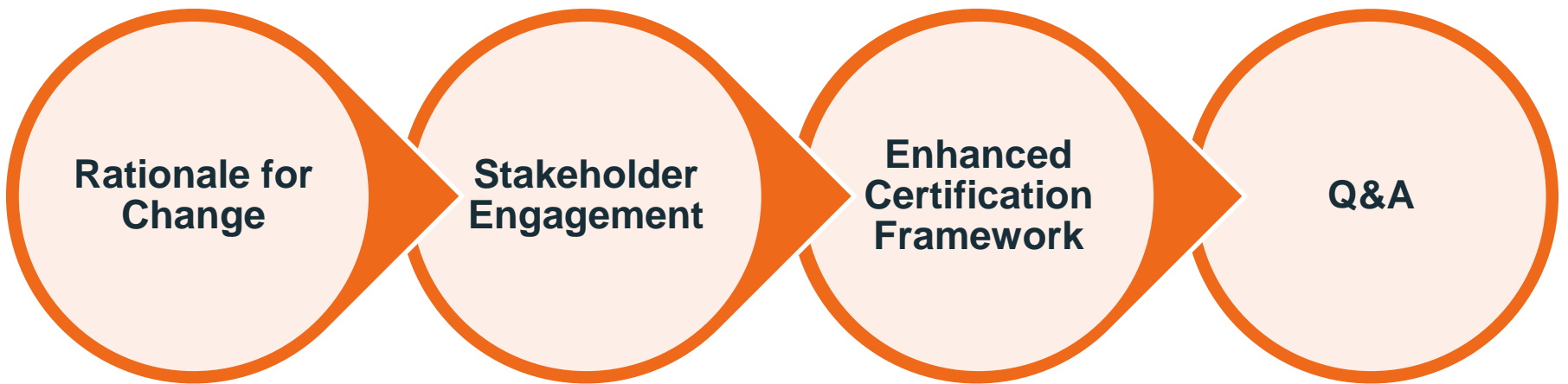

## Name Development

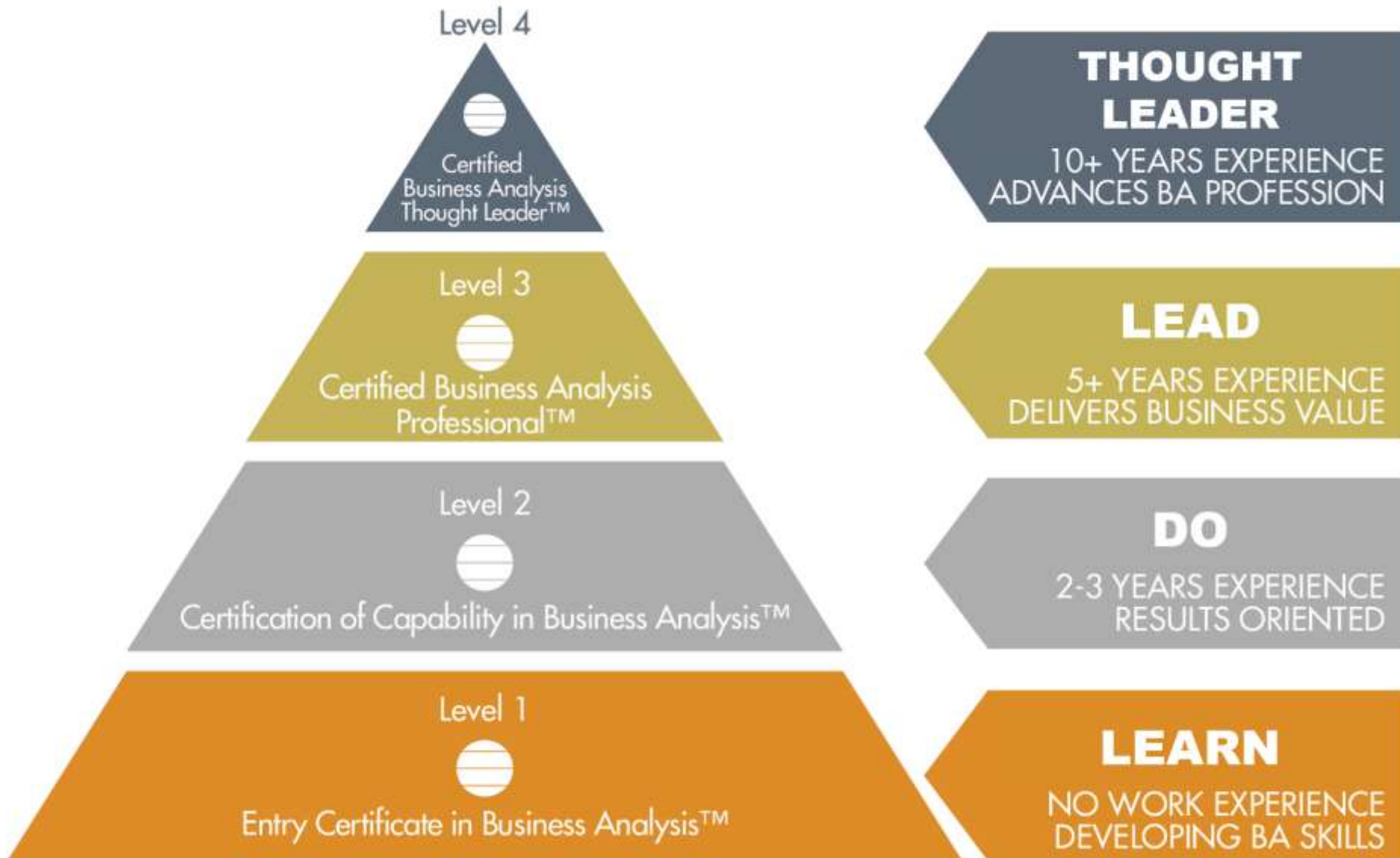
- New names based on

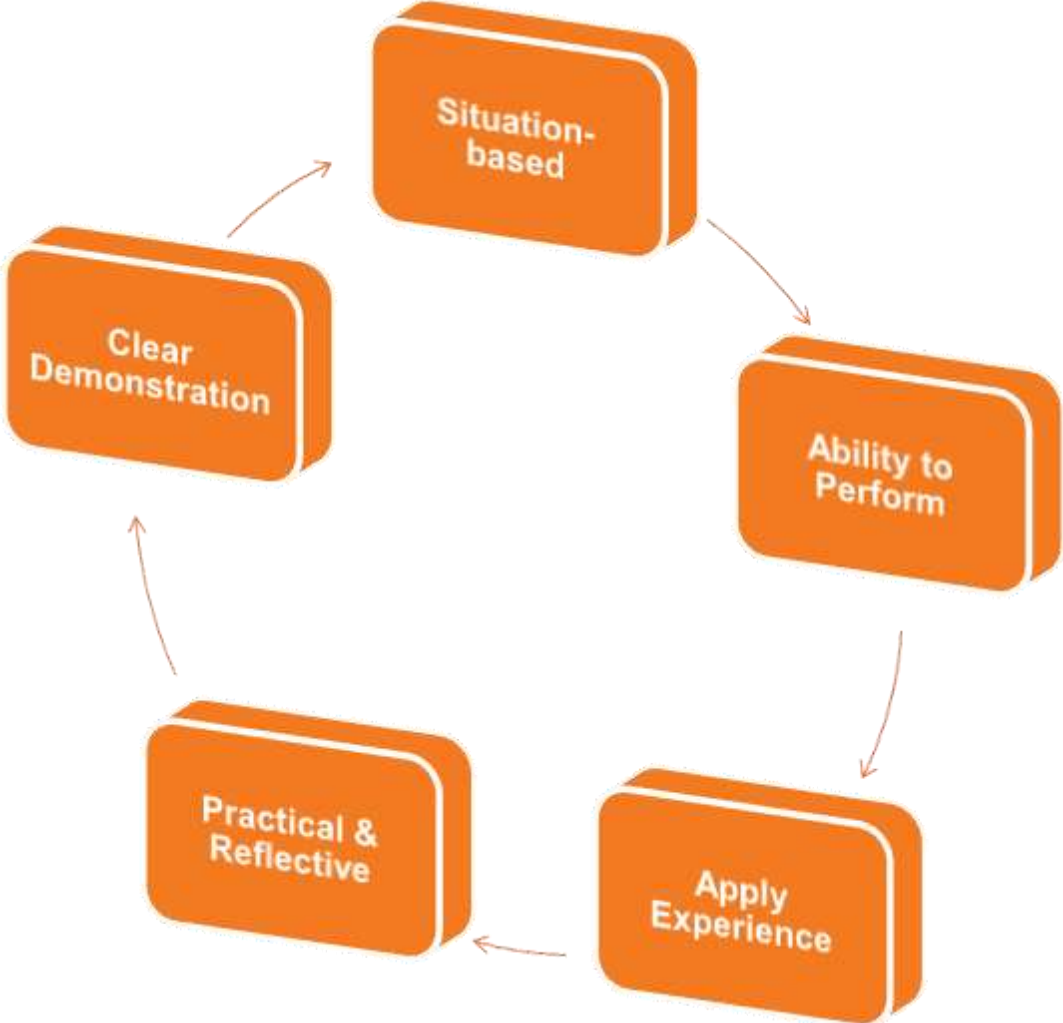

- Application Expiry = 1 year from approval
- Number of Exams = 3 within 1 year – no wait time in between required
