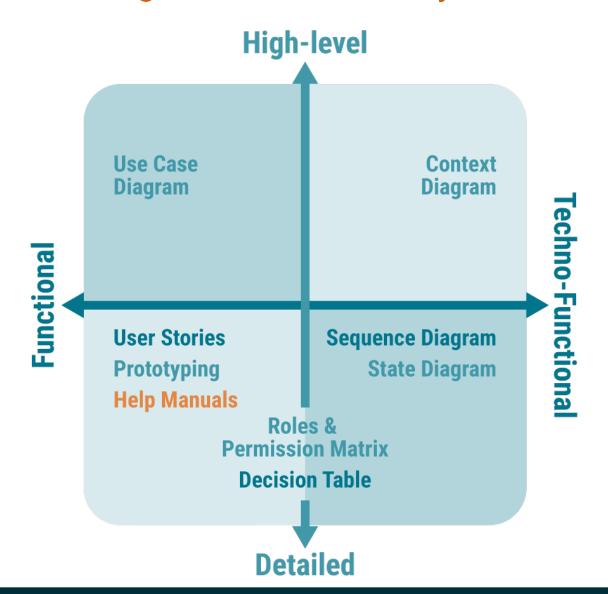

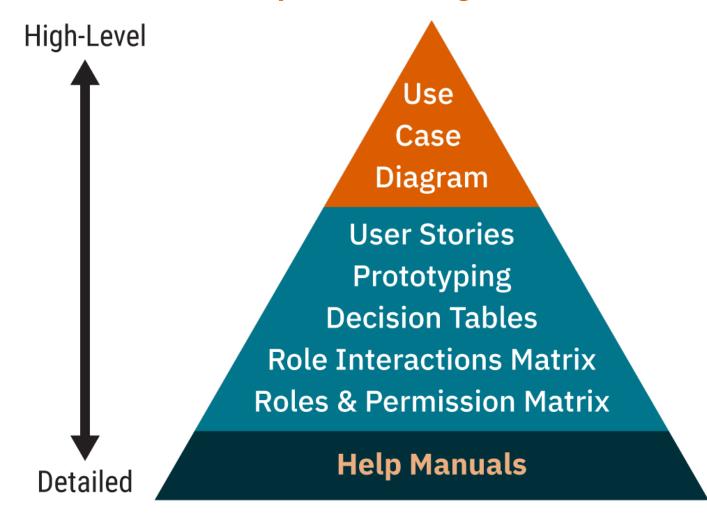

Steps

- 1. Identify stakeholders according to the scope identified:
 - System: IIBA Member Portal
 - User Roles: Members
- 2. Analyze existing documentation (if any),
- 3. Identify logical flow of user actions or user journey for each role while accessing the functionality, and
- 4. Meet the users from various roles to identify high level user interactions in terms of functions performed.



Steps

- 1. Note the steps one-by-one as a user would be performing them.
- 2. Follow the Meeting Checklist document to see if all the points are covered.
- 3. Capture relevant screenshots / images after each step.
- 4. You can include videos for additional information.
- 5. You can show the information in tabular format, or in points.
