To Answer Exam Questions and Navigate Through the Screens

When you are ready to answer, select your option and then select Answer.

- □ The system will save your answer and move you to the next question
- □ Navigation buttons are located at the top and bottom of the screen

Top Navigation Buttons:

- D Prev and Next are used to move back and forward
- □ Nav shows a summary of the questions answered, unanswered and flagged

Bottom Navigation Buttons:

- $\hfill\square$ Are used to move from question to question
- □ Highlight the question that is currently being answered
- Are used to **flag** questions that you want to go back to later, as long as time permits
- **Flags** will remain until you clear them and are used to highlight any questions that you want to review

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Ending the Exam Correctly



When you have answered all questions and are ready to submit your exam, select the **End Test** button located at the top of the screen.

A message will appear to show you any unanswered or flagged questions.

Select **Close** if you want to go back to these questions if time permits.

If you are ready to submit your exam, select **End Test**.

This will take you to a final screen where you will be asked to confirm your option. **Are you sure you want to end the test?**



You can:

- □ Select **Cancel** to return to the questions (if time permits)
- $\hfill\square$ Select \mathbf{OK} to end the test

NOTE: Do not press the red X in the corner of the screen as it is not the proper way to close the exam and you will not get your result properly.

When you select OK, your test will close, and you will receive a pass or fail result on the screen. IIBA does not provide exam scores.

Within two business days, you will receive an email from IIBA with your exam performance summary and any next steps required.
