ACADEMIC PROGRAM'S CURRICULUM/CURRICULA ENDORSEMENT PROCESS

Value

Having a course(s) and/or program IIBA endorsed is:

- Great for your institution's marketing.
- Once endorsed, your programs/courses, given your institution's consent, will be advertised within the globally accessible <u>Endorsed Education and Training</u> webpage.
- Great for the IIBA®/professional community.
- Great for your current and prospective students.
- When a student learns that a program/course(s) is *IIBA Endorsed*, they know that:
 - o It is aligned to the BABOK® Guide or the Agile Extension to the BABOK Guide (either an area, multiple areas, or the entirety).
 - It educates them on internationally, industry recognized standards and best practices of business analysis.
 - It will contribute towards their preparation of a respective IIBA certification exam;
 thereby, significantly reducing their study time after the program/course is complete.
 - They can confidently apply it against the professional development requirement within their CCBA® or CBAP® application if the program/course's start and end dates are within the required timeframe.

Criteria

A program/course/group of courses can be submitted to be evaluated by IIBA for endorsement if its curriculum/combined curricula is at least 75% aligned to the BABOK Guide or the Agile Extension to the BABOK Guide (either to an area/topic, multiple areas/topics, or the entirety).

Application

The application is electronic and can only be completed by the primary contact to your institution or an IIBA Member of your institution with access to the Academic Program's benefits of features. The application's link is located within the Academic Resources webpage, only accessible to Academic Program Members. <u>Appendix A</u> is a sample of this application.

A single submission of this application can represent a single course, multiple courses together or a program. Once submitted to IIBA, the application is sent to IIBA's accessors, a group of subject matter experts, who require at least 2 weeks to review.

Completion Instructions

- Application type: Recognized Course
- General information on the curriculum/curricula.
 - Program/course/courses' name, website, duration in hours (If the application represents multiple courses or a program, please provide the duration of the program or total duration of all the courses' contact hours), audience (private or public), delivery channel (classroom, online or blended), language, what countries and cities does the program service, and summary of learning objectives.
- Processes to describe how the course(s)/program is administered.
 - This section is to ensure that there are proper processes in place to evaluate the students' proficiency of the learning objectives, to select an instructor suitable to teach the learning objectives, and to evolve the curriculum/curricula based on the students' need, new and revised information, and industry's need. It asks to:
 - Describe methods used to evaluate the learning objectives.
 - Describe the instructor selection process and qualifications.
 - Please include information on the hired or current instructor, if possible. If your institution is planning on advertising that the curriculum/curricula prepares students for one of our certifications, the instructor should already have the respective certification or a plan to achieve the respective certification within a year from the date when the curriculum/curricula is granted IIBA endorsement. Exceptions, at our discretion, can be make for instructors with appropriate and very extensive background.
 - Describe the process for collecting student feedback.
 - Describe the curriculum development and revision process.
- BABOK Guide Elements.
 - Describe how the learning objectives are aligned to the BABOK Guide's knowledge domains, underlying competencies, techniques and perspectives.
