

Purpose

This Guide

To inform administrator(s) of IIBA Corporate Program members on IIBA New Corporate Member Onboarding program, in which the organization's employees newly assigned to IIBA Corporate membership will enter.

IIBA New Corporate Member On-boarding Program

IIBA Corporate Program member's administrator(s) is responsible to assign their organization's allotment of IIBA Corporate memberships to employees. IIBA is, then, committed to helping those employees, assigned to IIBA Corporate membership, achieve the full benefit from their IIBA Corporate membership through different engagement activities.

IIBA's New Corporate Member On-boarding program is designed to highlight resources and tools highly valued by business analysis professionals. This program is IIBA's first effort towards demonstrating the value of IIBA Corporate membership. An on-boarding program not only makes members aware of the resources and tools available to them but also provides them with context as to how those benefits can be used to achieve their goals. When IIBA Corporate members understand their benefits and how to access them, there is a greater chance of them becoming active, engaged members, and having a valuable experience.

Roles and Responsibilities

Corporate Program Member's Administrators

Administrators will:

- Assign employees to their organization's allotted IIBA Corporate memberships.
 - o If the employee already has an IIBA account, submit a request to IIBA to have the employee assigned, within which confirm the employee's preferred email address that will receive the on-boarding emails.
 - If the employee doesn't already have an IIBA account, create one for the employee through their IIBA portal using the employee's preferred email address that will receive the onboarding emails.
- Know how and when the IIBA Corporate member welcome series emails will be sent.
- Answer questions from their leadership or employees, to whom have been assigned to IIBA
 Corporate membership, about IIBA New Corporate Member On-boarding program in terms of its
 purpose and about the content within the emails of IIBA Corporate member welcome series.
- Escalate any questions on or issues with the emails to the IIBA via the email: corporatemembership@iiba.org.

The administrator(s) may, additionally, organize other on-boarding activities to encourage the use of IIBA Corporate membership's benefits. For suggestions or to discuss ideas on how to further engage IIBA Corporate members, please connect with your organization's IIBA Account Manager.

IIBA

IIBA will:

- Ensure that employees newly assigned to IIBA Corporate membership will enter IIBA New Corporate Member On-boarding program in a timely manner.
- Support IIBA Corporate Program member's administrator(s) in answering questions and resolving issues related to IIBA New Corporate Member On-boarding program.

Employees

Employees will report any issues in receiving or accessing any links within the emails of IIBA Corporate member welcome series to their organization's administrator of IIBA Corporate Program membership.



IIBA New Corporate Member On-boarding Program

IIBA New Corporate Member On-boarding program is an email sequence, made up of **9 emails delivered at 5 business day intervals**. Employees (which can include new administrators) newly assigned to IIBA Corporate membership will receive those emails over the first 45 days of their IIBA Corporate membership.

Qualification for the Program

For an employee or administrator to enter the program, they must meet the following conditions:

- Employees must be newly assigned to IIBA Corporate membership.
- Employees must have a current email address as their primary email address associated with their IIBA account at the time they are assigned to IIBA Corporate membership.

IIBA Corporate Member Welcome Series

IIBA Corporate member welcome series is an email sequence comprised of the emails listed within the following table and detailed in <u>Appendix A</u>. Each email has a specific theme which introduces the IIBA Corporate member to a selection of IIBA-curated resources and tools, and takes approximately 5 minutes to read. Each email also includes a call to action (CTA) to encourage the employee to experience how they can use those resources and tools. The first email of this sequence will be sent approximately 24 hours after the employee is assigned to IIBA Corporate membership. If the employee is assigned over a weekend or holiday or outside of business hours, the first email will be received on the following business day.

Frequently Asked Questions

	Question	Answer
1	How long after the employee is assigned to IIBA Corporate membership will they receive the first email?	Within 24 hours or the following business day if they are assigned to IIBA Corporate membership over a weekend or holiday.
2	Can I give you a list of employees to add to IIBA New Corporate Member On-boarding program?	Every IIBA Corporate Program member is given complimentary IIBA Corporate memberships; the number of which is dependent on the level in which the organization has enrolled. For an employee to receive IIBA Corporate member welcome series, the employee must first be assigned to either a complimentary IIBA Corporate membership or to one that is purchased by IIBA Corporate Program member. To assign an employee to IIBA Corporate membership, an administrator can assign them within their IIBA portal or submit a request to IIBA via the email: corporatemembership@iiba.org . Administrators can also send IIBA a list of employees, who should be assigned to a complimentary or purchased IIBA Corporate membership, to that same email address. Only those employees, who aren't already assigned to IIBA Corporate membership, will receive the email sequence. Please note that if an employee is already an IIBA Member at the time of being assigned to IIBA Corporate membership, they will not receive the email sequence because they are already receiving one related to that IIBA Membership.
3	What if we do not want any of our IIBA Corporate members to be entered into IIBA New Corporate Member Onboarding program?	Your IIBA Corporate members participating in IIBA New Corporate Member On-boarding program is highly recommended because it helps your organization realize the value of their IIBA Corporate Program membership. We do want to address your concerns, therefore, please connect with your organization's IIBA Account Manager.
4	Can we customize the email sequence that our IIBA Corporate members receive?	Unfortunately, we can't customize the email sequence for each IIBA Corporate Program member. This sequence can be complimented by additional efforts. Please connect with your organization's IIBA Account Manager to discuss ideas on how to enhance the on-boarding experience.
5	Our IIBA Corporate members are not receiving their emails. What should we do?	Emails sent from IIBA.org may be getting blocked by your organization's spam filtering. We recommend ensuring that IIBA.org is added as a trusted sender to your network or email corporatemembership@iiba.org for assistance.




