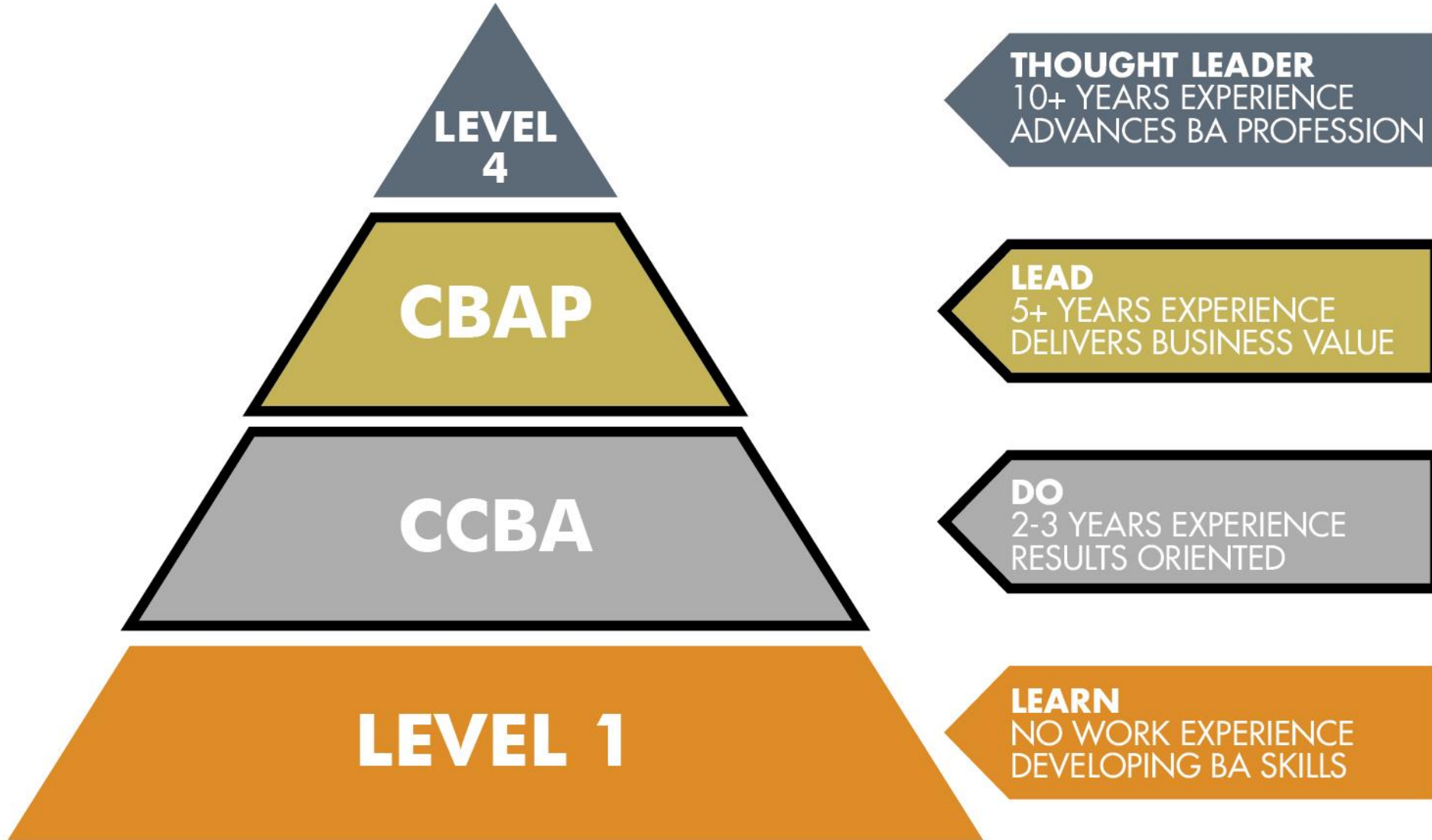

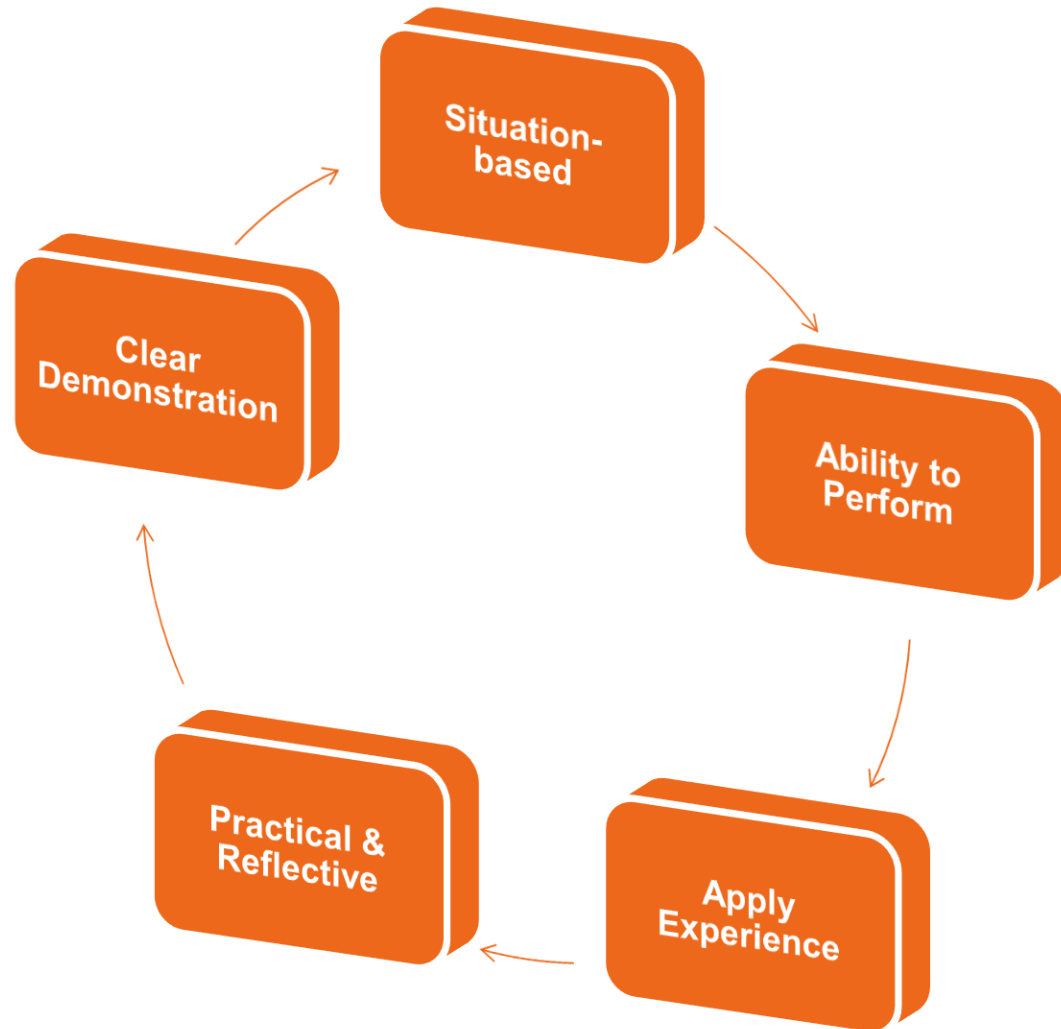

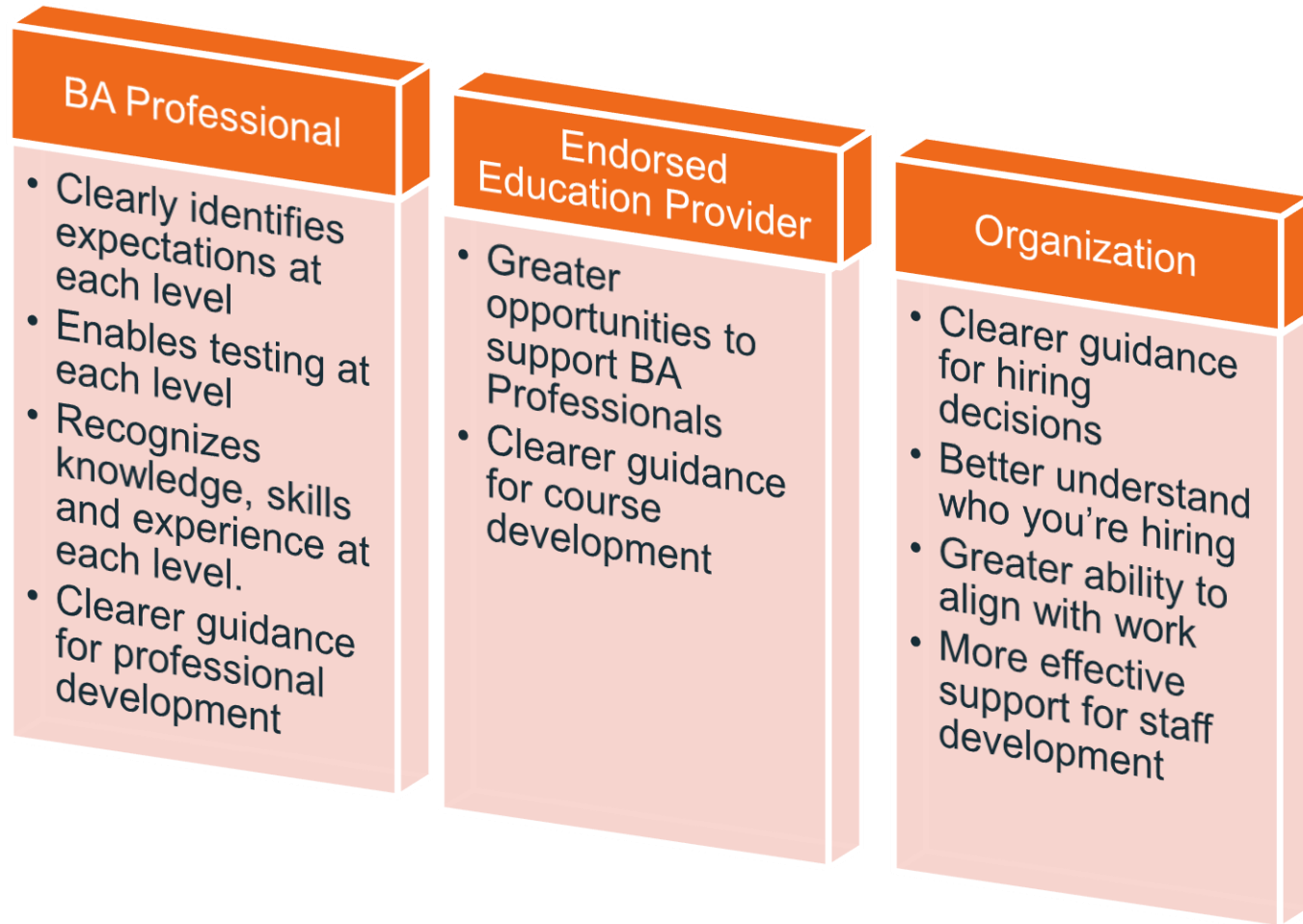
4 Level Certification Framework

Audience & Assessment

TARGET AUDIENCE

ASSESSMENT

Scenario-based examination
Situations described in a 2-4 sentences where candidates must answer a question based on the situation

Level 3 Audience & Assessment

TARGET AUDIENCE

- Current CBAPs
- Seasoned BAs
- BA Consultants
- Trainers

ASSESSMENT

Case study-based examination

Longer cases (1-1.5 pages) of information where candidates must analyze, synthesize, and evaluate the situation and answer multiple questions about the case

- Certification program consists of competency-based examinations that are reflective of nurse practitioner knowledge and expertise within clearly defined specialties

Business Analysis Planning & Monitoring Plan Stakeholder Engagement
